

## Fall Clean-Up Day: September 24 at the IGH Public Works Facility

Each year the City of Inver Grove Heights provides residents and the residents of West St. Paul the opportunity to get rid of unwanted items for a minimal fee. The annual Clean-Up Day is scheduled for Saturday, September 24, 2016 from 8:00 am to 12:00 noon. **This year's event is highlighting specific efforts to recycle certain items. We appreciate and encourage your participation in supporting the City in these recycling efforts.**

The clean-up event is held at the Inver Grove Heights Public Works Maintenance Facility, **8168 Barbara Avenue**, located behind City Hall. ### Items to be Recycled:

Bring us your gently used clothes, drapes, and curtains. There is a nonprofit organization that will repurpose these items for use by someone who needs them.	Bring your gently used furniture (including outdoor furniture) and it will be taken to local nonprofit organizations to be sold at discounted prices. Any item that cannot be recycled and re-used will be crushed and put into the landfill.	Drop-off shredding service will be available at both the Public Works Facility parking lot and the City Hall parking lot. Documents will be collected in secured bins, removed from the premises in secured transport vehicles, then shredded and baled to be recycled into tissue paper. The nonprofit organization that performs this service is AAA Certified by the National Association for Information Destruction (NAID), and provides jobs for people who otherwise have barriers to employment. All employees are background checked for maximum security.  It is <u>not</u> necessary to remove any binders, clips, staples, etc. for this service.	Bicycles/Parts in any condition will be taken away and either disassembled or refurbished. Our vendor will take parts from disassembled bikes and re-sell them at discounted prices, and refurbished bikes will be either donated to needy children or re-sold at discounted prices.

Generally countertop or wall mounted items.
